The college was affiliated to University of Pune and then to, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, until it became a constituent unit of this University in 2003. The undergraduate and postgraduate courses offered by the college have been recognized by Medical Council of India. M.B.B.S. degree from this college has been accepted by G.M.C., U.K.

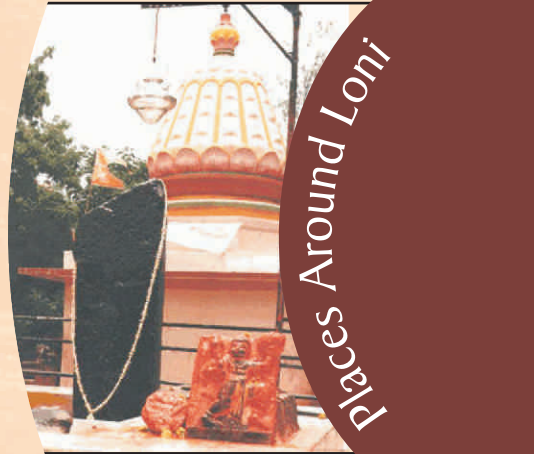

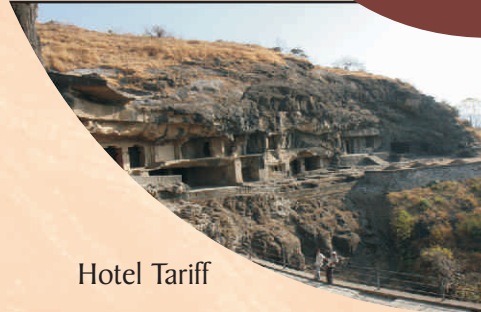
Saibaba Temple, Shirdi (22km)

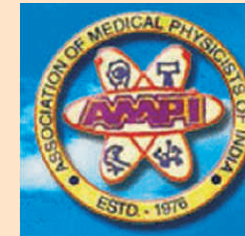
