



- 1. Only registered delegates can submit their papers.
- 2. Scientific paper/poster to be submitted initially in soft copy for evaluation by the expert committee latest by 30 Sep. 2022. The decision of expert committee shall be final.
- 3. All paper/poster received will be scrutinized by expert committee.
- 4. The corresponding author(s) of the posters/papers will be intimated regarding the acceptance of the abstract either as an AWARD paper, ORAL presentation or as a POSTER presentation as determined by the scientific committee.
- 5. There will be prizes in different categories for best scientific paper and poster. All papers presenters will receive certificates.
- 6. The selected oral papers will be presented at the podium on Day 2 i.e., 13th November 2022. The time and venue will be intimated in advance.
- 7. Oral presentation will be of 5 minutes followed by 2 minutes for discussion. Queries from the judges to be answered only by the presenter and co-author.
